

**UNIFI SECURES BIN PROJECT ENVIRONMENTAL PERMITS
FROM THE REPUBLIC OF ALBANIA
NATIONAL LICENSING CENTER**

NEW YORK, NY, USA – November 5, 2010 – UNIFI Communications (UNIFI), a leading US-based international carrier, today announced that all necessary environmental permits for the Balkans-Italy Network (BIN) Phase 1 construction activities in Albania were released by the National Licensing Center of the Republic of Albania to UNIFI Holdings Albania Branch, UNIFI's sister company in Albania.

Adrian Shatku, President and CEO of UNIFI explained, "Today's permission from Albania's Ministry of Environment, Forests and Water now clears the way for us to seek permissions at the local municipality levels for the actual physical construction activities related to the BIN project in Albania. With such great support being provided by the Albanian government, we can now begin moving this project forward much more aggressively."

As announced previously, Alcatel-Lucent will provide turn-key implementation of the BIN Phase 1 system, which is Albania's first private undersea fiber optic cable system. The network will connect Tirana, Albania to Bari, Italy and should begin providing service before the end of 2011.

Under the agreement, Alcatel-Lucent will also deploy optical equipment at the landing points of the network, which will link Italy to the newly created Balkans Internet eXchange (BIX) in Tirana. BIX is being developed by UNIFI to serve as Albania's first fiber-connected data center providing connectivity from Albania to all of the major telecommunications hubs located in Western Europe, including Milan, Frankfurt, Amsterdam, and London.

"As we reach each new significant milestone, there are fewer and fewer reasons remaining to justify any special or discounted pricing on BIN bandwidth services or for the BIX (Balkans-Internet eXchange) data center services. Obviously, now is the time for prospective customers to negotiate their best deals in order to secure lower network costs than competitors in Albania's retail multi-media services market. I would encourage all companies that desire more and higher quality bandwidth to contact us as soon as possible", suggested Brian Crawford, VP of Business Development for UNIFI.
